6. $\frac{\partial w}{\partial x} + a \frac{\partial w}{\partial y} = f(x, y).$

General solution:

$$w = \int_{x_0}^x f(t, y - ax + at) dt + \Phi(y - ax),$$

where $\Phi(u)$ is an arbitrary function and x_0 may be taken arbitrary.
