10. $\frac{\partial w}{\partial x} + f(x)g(y)h(w)\frac{\partial w}{\partial y} = 0.$

General solution:

$$\int \frac{dy}{g(y)} - h(w) \int f(x) dx = \Phi(w),$$

where $\Phi(w)$ is an arbitrary function.
