3.
$$\frac{\partial w}{\partial x} + f\left(\frac{\partial w}{\partial y}\right) = g(x)y + h(x).$$

Complete integral:

$$w = \varphi(x)y + \int [h(x) - f(\varphi(x))] dx + C_1, \quad \text{where} \quad \varphi(x) = \int g(x) dx + C_2,$$

C_1 and C_2 are arbitrary constants.
