



37. $y''_{xx} + xfy'_x - fy = 0, \quad f = f(x).$

Particular solution: $y_0 = x.$

Solution:

$$y = y_0 \left(C_1 + C_2 \int \frac{e^{-F}}{y_0^2} dx \right), \quad \text{where } F = \int x f dx,$$

C_1 and C_2 are arbitrary constants.
